Greetings Dayton High School Family!

I wanted to inform everyone of the change in schedule for students to all virtual beginning on Monday, November 23rd. Governor Beshear's announcement yesterday mandated that all middle/high schools move to virtual instruction beginning Monday, November 23rd. At this time, we understand the anticipated executive order will close elementary schools (grades K-5) to in-person classes until Dec. 7. After Dec. 7, elementary schools (grades K-5) will be permitted to resume in person classes through Jan. 4, 2021, only if they are not in a red zone county and if the school adheres to the Healthy at School Guidance.

Middle and high schools (grades 6-12) will be closed to in-person classes through Jan. 4.

Classes will begin **Virtually** on **Monday, November 23rd** at 8:45 a.m. For now, Governor Beshear has recommended that in-person instruction be delayed until **Monday, January 4th** at the earliest. Please see the schedule shared below for our virtual school - synchronous learning. Students will be expected to sign on using Google Classroom and meet with their teacher/classmates at each assigned time/day. Google Classroom will be our school center point for all learning and instruction.

Attendance and participation in these classes is required and all grades will count toward student's 2nd quarter grades. We will follow all grading policies and treat submission of all work the same as we would if we were holding in building instruction. By meeting with classes via Google Meet twice a week and allowing students the opportunity to schedule in person/virtual meeting with staff for tutoring, we will **not** follow grading procedures adopted in the spring to conclude the 2019-20 school year.

Asynchronous Instruction - learning that will occur outside of the designated class times.

Synchronous Instruction – instruction that will occur virtually in real time with teachers through google meet.

Vocational Students – ATC students will remain virtual until further notice.

Dual Credit Students - Gateway students will remain virtual until further notice.

Wednesday - On Wednesdays, asynchronous instruction will occur. Teachers will be setting up individual or small group meetings as needed. If a teacher is willing, students will also have the ability to set up a small

group meeting at school with the teacher for tutoring purposes. Upon arrival, all students/parents will have their temperature checked and will need to wear a mask. We ask that you abide by social distancing guidelines while on campus.
