## Engage for Deep Understanding

## #1 Understand Labels

Labels are the "what" of learning. The brain needs a name for content so that it can store it and retrieve it for the future.

Learning labels is superficial yet very important: it kick starts the process of understanding.

For example, noun-labels related to weather include *tornado*, *cloud*, *rain*, *hurricane*, *and snow* – all words that are easy to visualize.

Yet, children raised in poverty tend to have a poorer grasp of labels, connected to their smaller vocabularies which puts them behind their peers when school starts.

## "Short Term" Solutions you can use (p. 96):

- 1. Informally assess students' prior knowledge of the terms in your upcoming unit.
- 2. Connect their labels with other labels.
- 3. Capture the essentials.
