Committee Reports:

Mrs. Rubemeyer gave the report for the Culbertson and Volpenhein.

Ms. Seidel gave her report for middle grades English – she has worked Friday school to help with students failing and has started to give academic detention. Missing assignments is the largest reason why students are failing. The high percentage in 7th grade is likely due to the change from the elementary

Mr. K went over information about students failing Spanish class.

Mr. Workman went over his report for Practical Living and PE. He has a low percentage of students failing Practical living/ Has an awesome advance PE class – has a higher number of females and it has been very successful

Mr. Crutchleo – only has one student failing because of absences. Ask is an end of pathway test

Ms. Stewarts report was gone over by Mr. K – Missing assignments for 8 students is the cause for failing grades.

Mr. Mongomerty has 11 students in the DaytonA program. Three students will be leaving DaytonA and entering the regular classroom after break.

Student Achievement Report/Data and School Improvement Planning

Mr. Campbell's report on the civics assessment.

- The last assessment was given on May 15, 2018.
- 73% of all students who took the test passed, or 112 students.
- There were 42 students who failed. Of those, 15 are now juniors, 18 are sophomores, and 4 have since transferred out.
- Of the seniors that took the test (juniors at that time), there were only 5 that did not pass. This does not include students who have transferred to Dayton between now and the last assessment, if any.
- The policy that was approved by the board mandates that all freshmen and any juniors or seniors who have not yet passed will be assessed once per semester.
- Freshmen will be assessed in during Mr. Elrod's Integrated Social Studies class. The 15 juniors will be assessed during Mr. Campbell's U.S. History class. Any freshmen, juniors or seniors who are not enrolled in a social studies class will be assessed at a separate time.

Updated CSIP for approval – Angela Buschle made a motion to accept the CSIP. Seconded by Angela Gonzalez. Motion carried.

Winter Cert Report was given by Mrs. Rubemeyer and Mr. Kellinghaus – Freshman did well; increasing in each subject. Sophomores are being looked at to see what can be done to help increase their scores. There are good discussions about what RTI will look like next year.

Julie Rubemeyer went over the Writing Policy and answered questions. Angela Buchle made a motion to accept the writing policy. Seconded by Erin Goetz. Motion carried.
