Unified Arts:

- STUDENTS WILL BEGIN TO RECOGNIZE AND IDENTIFY THE ELEMENTS OF MUSIC THROUGH PERFORMING, SINGING, PLAYING INSTRUMENTS, MOVING, LISTENING, READING MUSIC, WRITING MUSIC, AND CREATING MUSIC INDEPENDENTLY AND WITH OTHERS.
- STUDENTS WILL BEGIN TO RECOGNIZE AND IDENTIFY ELEMENTS OF DANCE AND BASIC DANCE FORMS THROUGH CREATING, COPYING AND PERFORMING PATTERNS OF MOVEMENT INDEPENDENTLY AND WITH OTHERS.
- STUDENTS WILL BEGIN TO RECOGNIZE AND IDENTIFY ELEMENTS OF DRAMA THROUGH CREATING AND PERFORMING DRAMATIC WORKS INDEPENDENTLY AND WITH OTHERS.
- STUDENTS WILL BEGIN TO RECOGNIZE AND IDENTIFY ELEMENTS OF ART AND PRINCIPLES OF DESIGN THROUGH CREATING ARTWORKS INDEPENDENTLY AND WITH OTHERS.

GRADING SCALE:
